They will be provided with ongoing support and a connection to their roots and culture, creating a sense of pride for their cultural teachings and history. They will have a full understanding of and be aware of all the resources and benefits that their community has available to them to help prepare for their future.</li>   <li><b>2. Social workers from the Ministry of Children and Family Development or a Delegated Aboriginal Agency in cultural planning for any children in care from either your community or communities served by your agency?</b></li> </ol>	

The Ministry will be aware of all culturally relevant programs and services available to our children in care. The social workers will have a point of contact and ongoing support that streamlines service delivery and planning for our children in care. Duplication of each process will not be necessary.

The band will have an opportunity to provide culturally relevant and current information and resources to the process. The nation will have an active statement in support of the children in care. Ensure relevant, current, consistent approach to supporting of the nation’s children and their connection to their culture, history, traditions and community connections.
