Policy	Students who are unable to attend the training without external funding and have exhausted other funding avenues may be eligible to receive a partial bursary through IPS.

Procedures	<p>Students who feel they are eligible by the criteria outlined above can apply for one of two available IPS partial bursaries per session.</p> <p>Each successful bursary recipient will be required to pay a \$250 administrative fee.</p> <p>Applications can only be made:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• up until one month in advance of the listed starting date for the Gladue session• By downloading the bursary application from IPS's website and submitting the full application and required letter to the designated IPS Administration listed here: https://ipsociety.ca/training/justice-equity/gladue-writing-training/ <p>Applications received outside of this time frame cannot be considered.</p> <p>Applicants can apply once per session. There is no limit to applying for future sessions, should the application not be selected initially.</p> <p>IPS bursaries are not based on academic grades. They are based on assessed need and potential to excel as a Gladue writer, as identified through the application and required Letter of Recommendation.</p> <p>Applications are reviewed and recipients chosen by a review panel that does not include the instructor.</p> <p>Successful applicants will be informed at least 20 days before the start of the course.</p> <p>Unsuccessful candidates will not be notified.</p>
