OBJECTIVES

The Indigenous Perspectives Society (IPS) is pleased to offer two streams of funding twice a year: Paddle fund for up to \$500 and Canoe fund for up to \$2,000. These awards are aimed at supporting Indigenous youth in revitalizing and sustaining their cultural practices. They honour the legacy of our former leader and cherished friend, the late Linda Lucas.

In line with Linda's values and leadership, these awards aim to empower young people by providing financial support for initiatives that promote Indigenous culture, relationship building, knowledge transfer, and overall wellness.

ELIGIBILITY

Funds are available to Indigenous youth from childhood to age of 34 living in British Columbia.

STEPS TO APPLY

1. Complete the Application & Gather a Letter of Support

Download the application from the [IPS website](#). You can print it out and write on it, type it up, or answer the questions in an email.

Ask a community member to write a Letter of Support highlighting your dedication and commitment to your initiative that: promotes Indigenous culture, relationship building, knowledge transfer, and/or overall wellness.
